Overview

The Juniors Team Coach is primarily responsible for developing the skills of the junior players within the team and ensuring players participate in a fun and safe environment.

Core Responsibilities

- ➤ Liaise with Age Group Coach and Team Managers to organise weekly training sessions.
- Liaise with Age Group Coach and Juniors Development Officer to develop individual players skills
- ➤ Attend all training sessions and matches for team.
- > Organise batting and bowling order on match days.
- ➤ Give a fair go to all players (refer ECC Junior Fair Go Policy).
- ➤ Model and promote Spirit of Cricket philosophy.

Additional Responsibilities

- > Provide guidance to players on match day.
- > Umpire on match day.
- > Train, mentor and support an incoming Juniors Team Coach.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- ➤ Know all players in team and their development needs.
- ➤ Sound knowledge of cricket skills and training techniques.
- ➤ Knowledge of Laws of Cricket and Association pennant rules.
- ➤ Knowledge of South East Cricket Association rules and regulations.
- ➤ Knowledge of the Laws of Cricket.
- ➤ Knowledge of and ability to impart the basic skills of cricket.

Personal Qualities

- > Effective communicator.
- > Ability to organise tasks.
- ➤ Must be able to engage and organise children.

Qualifications

- Required Working With Children Check (if over 18).
- ➤ Required Community Coach Accreditation.
