Position Description

Overview

The JG Craig Coach is primarily responsible for selecting, coaching then supporting the JG Craig squad in the annual carnival in January.

Core Responsibilities

- Liaise with the Juniors Development Officer to invite potential JG Craig squad members to the winter Todd Squad development sessions.
- Attend Todd Squad sessions, providing coaching as required.
- Conduct JG Craig trials utilising coaching from senior club.
- Select a squad of 13 players to represent the Club in the carnival.
- Provide game day coaching to captain and players.

Additional Responsibilities

- Attend Juniors Committee Meetings.
- Report on activities to the Club Executive Committee via the Juniors Portfolio Manager.
- Provide a JG Craig Coach's report for the Club Annual Report.
- Train, mentor and support an incoming JG Craig Coach.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- A knowledge of the Cricket Pathway.
- Understand the VSDCA pennant rules under which matches are conducted.
- Understand the Cricket Australia bowling limitations for underage players.
- Understand match day tactics.
- Knowledge of team members abilities and capabilities.
- A good knowledge of cricket skills and training techniques.

Personal Qualities

- Effective leader and communicator.
- Must be able to engage and organise children.

Qualifications

- Required - Working With Children Check (if over 18).
- Required - Community Coach Accreditation.
- Preferred - Representative Coach Accreditation.

Expected Time Requirement

Approximately 75 hours per annum.
