Club Champion (First Eleven)

Presented to the player who accumulates the most points for the season (including finals) for performances in First Eleven matches only providing the player is eligible under the terms specified in the Club's Rules.

Points are awarded as follows: -

1.	Bowling - Per Unassisted Wicket	20 points.
	(Bowled, LBW, Hit Wicket)	
2.	Bowling - Per Assisted Wicket	10 points.
	(Caught, Stumped)	
3.	Run Outs - Per Unassisted Dismissal	20 points
4.	Run Outs - Per Assisted Dismissal	10 points
5.	Fielding - Per Dismissal	10 points.
	(Catches, Stumpings)	_
6.	Batting - Per Run	1 point.

If after counting there is a tie for the highest number of points, then each player with that number of points is declared joint winner.

Wickas Shield (senior elevens)

Presented to the player who accumulates the most votes across all elevens for the season providing the person is eligible under the terms specified in the Club's Rules.

Two players in each team shall confer and after reaching consensus award votes on a 3, 2, 1 basis for performances in each match of the season (excluding finals). A player's votes are tallied across all elevens to determine the winner of the award. If after counting there is a tie for the highest number of votes then each player with that number of votes is declared joint winner.

Barry N Todd Shield

Presented to the person or persons judged to have made the most outstanding contribution as a volunteer to the Club during the season. Winner or winners decided by majority vote of the committee.



Batting Average Winner (Senior Elevens)

Presented to the player in each eleven with the highest batting average for the season (including finals) who is qualified according to the following criteria: -

- 1. Player must be eligible under the terms specified in the Club's Rules.
- 2. Player must have made at least 300 runs for the season in the grade.
- 3. Where no player is qualified under criteria 2, any player who has made at least 150 runs for the season in the grade <u>and</u> batted at least half as many times as the player who had the most innings for the season in the grade becomes qualified.
- 4. Where no player is qualified under criteria 2 or 3, the player who makes the most runs in the grade becomes qualified.

Where the highest batting average is shared by more than one qualified player each player is declared joint winner.

Bowling Average Winner (Senior Elevens)

Presented to the player in each eleven with the lowest bowling average for the season (including finals) who is qualified according to the following criteria: -

- 1. Player must be eligible under the terms specified in the Club's Rules.
- 2. Player must have taken at least 20 wickets for the season in the grade.
- 3. Where no player is qualified under criteria 2, any player who has taken at least 10 wickets for the season in the grade <u>and</u> bowled at least half as many overs as the player who bowled the most overs for the season in the grade becomes qualified.
- 4. Where no player is qualified under criteria 2 or 3, the player who takes the most wickets in the grade becomes qualified.

Where the lowest bowling average is shared by more than one qualified player each player is declared joint winner.



Batting Recognition (Senior Elevens)

Outstanding Batting Award

Presented to the player who makes the highest single innings score across all elevens. Where more than one player makes the highest score for the season then each player is declared joint winner.

Batting Medallion

Presented to a player for each innings in which a score of 100 or more runs is achieved.

Bowling Recognition (Senior Elevens)

Outstanding Bowling

Presented to the player who takes the highest number of wickets for the lowest number of runs in a single innings across all elevens. Where more than one player takes the most wickets for the least runs for the season then each player is declared joint winner.

Bowling Medallion

Presented to a player for each innings in which five or more wickets are taken.

Hat-Trick Award

Presented to each player who takes three or more wickets with consecutive deliveries. The wickets may be taken in separate overs and / or innings.

Under 21 Player of the Year

Presented to the player who accumulates the most points for the season for performances in matches across all senior grades (excluding finals) only providing the player is eligible under the terms specified in the Club's Rules.

Points are awarded as follows: -

1.	Wickets – Per Dismissal	15 points.
3.	Fielding - Per Dismissal	5 points.
6.	Batting - Per Run	1 point.

Points are uplifted with a multiplication factor according to the grade in which they are accrued: -

1 st XI	4 times
2 nd XI	3 times
3 rd XI	2 times
4 th XI	1 times

If after counting there is a tie for the highest number of points, then each player with that number of points is declared joint winner.



Junior Awards

Awarded at discretion of Junior Committee and Team Coaches / Managers.

Generally, the following will be awarded: -Batting Award Bowling Award Managers / Coaches Award President's Award Other awards may be made at discretion of Junior Committee.
