

Specialist Coach Position Description

Overview

The Specialist Coach is primarily responsible for providing hands on coaching to individual players to develop skills within their area of expertise.

Core Responsibilities

- > Liaise with the Senior Coach to identify development opportunities for specific players.
- > Observe training performances to identify deficiencies in technique of individual players.
- > Discuss training goals and needs with individual players.
- > Provide coaching of skill technique to individual players.
- Assist the Senior Coach to ensure that training runs effectively and that the development needs of each player in the club are met.
- > Review individual player performances.
- > Assist Junior Development Officer to provide coaching / mentorship to junior players.
- Assist with Todd Squad sessions.
- > Liaise with guest coaches to provide specialised coaching.

Additional Responsibilities

- > Inform Senior Coach as to what coaching has been provided to individual players.
- > Continually improve coaching by referencing other sporting organisation's techniques.

Knowledge and Skills Required

- > Know all players likely to play senior cricket and their development needs.
- > Sound knowledge of cricket skills and training techniques.
