# **SENIORS**

It was a season of growth in the seniors at ECC which saw two new teams (Women's and Men's 5ths) and significant improvement in our 1st-4th XI men's performances.

We achieved an 11th placed finish of 32 clubs in the Victorian Sub District Cricket Association (VSDCA) Club Championship, up from 22nd of 28 clubs in 2020/21.

Our 1st and 2nd XI men's sides both won more games than they lost, finishing 8th of 16 sides, but were perhaps a little unlucky not to play finals as only the top 6 sides qualified.

Our 3rds and 4th XI men's sides both qualified for finals after strong campaigns. Disappointingly, both lost their final to the eventual premiers but should be proud of their efforts throughout the season.

Our Men's 5ths and Women's sides finished off their seasons in style with comprehensive victories against higher placed opposition, the women's victory being our first in history! It was a great reward for all the hard work that has gone on behind the scenes to establish the teams and in the case of the women's win, a terrific send off for Kay Crowley who (sadly for us) has moved to sunny Queensland for work. The Crowley's have made an incredible contribution to the ECC over many years and we wish them all the very best on their new adventure!



## SOCIAL


It was a very social end to the season!


