Who is allowed to play?	Any female over the age of 14 is eligible to play. We are looking for you to reach out and help us build our team. If you are female and would like to join or your mother, your sister, your wife, your aunty, your grandmother, your friend, your colleague anyone at all - everyone is welcome.		
Do I need experience?	The competition is available to clubs across the Southern Bayside region, and for anyone wanting to give cricket a go.		
	It is a social competition for those who have little to no experience. So if you are female and aged 14 years and over you are welcome		
	Everyone is welcome and encouraged to join and the competition caters for all levels of ability with the focus being on participation and enjoying the experience of playing cricket.		
	This competition has specific rules to make sure that this remains a social game that is accessible to all. The games will have a little competition but we want you to meet new people and enjoy your time learning new skills.		
What is the registration fee?	The registration fee for this competition is \$200 full price \$150 concession.		
	The fee also helps to pay for equipment, cricket balls, ground hire and events throughout the season.		
	The club will provide a complementary hat and playing shirt to all first year participants.		
	We are all working collectively to minimise the cost to play.		
What do you need to wear?	Players will be required to play in a Club shirt, club hat and white cricket pants.		
	At club training you can wear whatever feels comfortable (but club training shirts are strongly encouraged, these are available to purchase through SWIVS locker along with an array of other club merchandise).		
What equipment do I need to play?	If you have your own cricket gear - great - you can use that. If you don't that is not an issue we have club kits for you to use. Clubs provide everything - bats, balls, stumps, pads, gloves, helmets. The only thing you must provide your own of is a personal protector (if you wish to wear one and we have some of those available to give you) and we suggest purchasing a pair of batting inners.		
	Coaches and club members can assist in providing names of places and the type of equipment to buy.

Where and when will training be?	Training will be at our practice net facility on St Kilda Street and will likely be one shared session with Senior Mens. The shared session will generally be on a Thursday night with dinner available at the club post training.			
	U16 training will be timed to dovetail into senior women's training to increase ties across the club and develop pathways for Junior to senior transitions.			
	Training generally runs from Early September until the end of the season with specialist sessions at indoor nets during the winter months.			
When will games be played?	Games are played on a Sunday afternoon at 12 pm.			
Where will the games be played?	The games will be played as a home and away fixture. The grounds for the competition will be determined before the season commences. Home games will at ECC's home ground at Elsternwick Park.			
	Opposing teams are listed below and range in distance from the club.			
What will be the format of the games?	Games will be a modified T20 format.			
How long will a game take?	Games will all be one day games lasting between 2 – 3 hours.			
Who will coach the team?	We have a panel of very experienced coaches at the club and in the spirit of integration these coaches will take responsibility for both men's and women's teams.
